Objectives :-

- Draft basic pattern blocks with given specifications or measurements taken from human body.
- Develop a variety of patterns for selected simple collarless tops and skirts using basic block via manipulation methods.
- Label and mark individual pattern pieces with symbols and notches based on industrial practices.
- Sew a simple top and skirt against given specifications or measurements.
- Evaluate product against given specifications or measurements.
- Take follow-up actions for non-conformance.

Entry Requirement :-

Singapore/PR Students:

- GCE 'N' Level with 3 credits including English and Mathematics OR
- WSQ ES WPLN Level 4 and above

International Students:

- High School Diploma equivalent to GCE 'N' Level with 3 credits including English and Mathematics OR
- Qualifications from professional institutes may be considered on a case-by-case basis AND/OR
- Pass TaF.tc Entrance Test

English Language Requirement –

- Possess a minimum credit in English at GCE 'O' Level or its equivalent OR
- IELTS score 4.5 or TOEFL score 450

ALL Students are required to have basic knowledge of computer and Microsoft Office

Graduation Requirements :-

Student must fulfil the following requirements:

- 75% attendance rate of total training hours per module
- Be found competent during written, practical and oral assessments

Student Pass Holders – a minimum of 90% attendance per month will be required.

Certificate Issuance :-

Upon successful completion of the course, student will be awarded the Statement of Attainment (SOA) for WSQ Develop Apparel Patterns through Drafting and Sew Basic Tops and Skirt. WSQ Certification is nationally endorsed and recognised by industry partners.

FAQs :-

1. I have no prior knowledge in sewing. Can I still enrol?

Yes, you can! Our Basic and Drafting Sewing course is open to beginners. Just bring your enthusiasm along and have fun!

2. Can I jump and take the intermediate courses without taking the basic sewing? I have prior sewing experience.

No, you can't. Due to the intensive course content, you are required to follow this learning pathway:

- 1) Basic Drafting and Sewing (Sleeveless Top and Skirt)
- 2) Intermediate Drafting and Sewing (Shirt and Pants) OR
- 3) Pattern Drafting and Sewing- Dress
- 3) Pattern Drafting and Sewing-Jacket

As for Basic Alteration & Pinning for Alteration, these modules have no pre-requisites and are open to beginners.

3. What happens if I do not meet the 75% attendance requirements?

If you do not meet the 75% attendance requirement, you will not be eligible to sit for the assessment.

As 90% of the total course fees are funded by the government, you will be liable to pay back to TaF.tc the amount that the government has subsidised if the student does not meet the 75% attendance requirement or attain a 'pass' grade for assessment.

4. Can I miss one or two lessons?

We highly discourage you from missing any classes since the entire program is designed to be hands-on intensive. Make sure you block off your time during your training with us or find an intake option that will ensure you do not miss any classes. You will only wish that you had more time in the class!

5. Are there any make-up or replacement classes?

We do not offer any make-up or replacement classes.

6. Can I enrol at your campus?

Enrolling in our campus is exactly the same as enrolling online. You will still be enrolling on the same online form and make payment online (we accept only VISA / MASTER / AMEX.)

7. What do I do if I'm planning to use my SkillsFuture Credit?

If you prefer to use your SkillsFuture Credit, just select "pay by SkillsFuture Credit" when you come across

the payment page in our online enrolment. Base on this scenario, there are 2 things for you to take note of:

- You will only be charged an application fee of SGD 12.84 on our online enrolment form upon clicking "submit"
- You will be submitting your skillsFuture credit claim to pay for your course fee by visiting <http://www.skillsfuture.sg/Credit>. The window period to submit your claim will start 60 days before the start date of your course. At the very latest, you should submit your claim 5 days before the start date of your course.
